Profile

- A teacher by profession, holds a Master's Degree in Executive Management and continues to pursue lifelong learning in spiritual and academic development.
- She is principal of the Eternal Light Community Vocational School.
- Co-founder of and Dean of Studies at the Catholic Bible Institute which offers programmes in Scripture and Pastoral Care.
- Archdiocesan Directress of the Pontifical Mission Societies in the Archdiocese of Port of Spain

Achievements:

- Foundress of the Eternal Light Community (ELC) -a Public Association of Christ faithful.
 - Opened the Eternal Light Community Vocational School which caters for students with special needs and students who have challenges in the mainstream educational institutions.
 - In 2002 opened the doors of 'A Child's World (2002)' which was founded to educate and rehabilitate children who suffer with Fetal Alcohol Syndrome and other drug-related conditions.

Service to Women at Risk

• As leader of ELC Sr Deborah collaborated with others to provide safe houses and services for women who suffer the consequences of abusive relationships. GOSHEN and Vision of Hope Home for battered women and their children these provide space for recuperation and for some, a new beginning.

Service to Abandoned Boys and Girls

• JOSHUA Boys Home for boys and AMICA Home for Girls were both opened in 2002. These homes provide parental care, education, social, spiritual and personal development for boys and girls who have been abandoned by their parents or whose parents, for several reasons cannot provide the care they need.

Service to Communities at Risk

- Sr. Deborah and the Eternal Light Community have extended services of care and prayer to 'at risk' communities – communities considered as 'Hot Spots'
 - In Enterprise, where Etta's House hosts weekly prayer meeting, provides food and clothing for those in need, counselling and house-to house visitation and Crusades. They also provide a space for after-school study for primary school students.
 - In Diego Martin, the Agapé House the Community provides counselling and prayer; hot meals, clothing and other household needs at their thrift shop. Prayer meeting is held twice weekly.
 - Sea Lots, Beetham Gardens. In these communities, ELC members, under the guidance of Sr Deborah visit and pray and counsel residents as well as organize crusades. They have also been provided with assistance for school placements, food hampers.

Service to the Aged

- Under the guidance of Sr Deborah de Rosia the Eternal Light Community offers care to aging persons at the following locations: Casa de Luz, Tunapuna; Belmont and Diego Martin.

Service to the Church

- Appointed by the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Port-of-Spain, Deborah leads a team of persons to care for pregnant teenagers at the Mary Care Centres in Port of Spain and South Oropouche
- Pastors the parish of Sacred Heart in Delaford, Tobago.
- Serves as Archdiocesan Directress of the Pontifical Mission Societies
- Spearheads the Hospitalization Visitation Ministry where members in this ministry visit the sick and shut-ins at hospitals and at homes.

Project/s being worked on:

- Since start of the Pandemic Monthly food distribution to persons in need in our society.
- Assisted residents of Sea Lots 3 with the rebuilding of their homes which were destroyed by fire.
- Major project at this time: Establishment of a Vocational School for the residents in the Sea Lots Community which is intended to assist both youth and adults.


GOD WILL TAKE CARE OF YOU
